He is also the President of the Management Board of the Archaeological Museum in Zadar; a member of the Management Boards of the Croatian History Museum; of the Croatian Museum Documentation Centre; and of the ICOMOS Croatia, respectively; a corresponding member of the German Archaeological Institute and a number of other heritage associations.

He has a profound and long-standing interest and experience in archaeology and cultural tourism both in Croatia as well as internationally. Among the notable projects he authored or led are *Archaeology and Tourism in Croatia*, *The Neanderthal Trail*, which both included large exhibitions and scientific catalogues in English; international conference on archaeology and tourism entitled *Sense and Sustainability*; international programme *Festival of EU Archaeology*, and many others.
